Anabel Z. Romero Court Executive Officer **NEEDLES, CA**— San Bernardino Superior Court (SBSC) is excited to announce the expansion of the Needles Courthouse clerk's office services from one day each month to five days a week beginning on Monday, January 23, 2023.

With a phased-in approach, residents of Needles and the surrounding areas will have access to in-person court services five days a week – services that have not been fully restored since the severe state-wide budget reductions in 2009 following the Great Recession.

Beginning on January 23, 2023, court users can access services Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. These services include: filing a document, making fine and fee payments, and scheduling a court hearing. Virtual Self-Help services will be provided daily and in-person services will continue on a monthly basis for all court users.

The second phase will expand opportunities for litigants to appear in person for court hearings with a judicial officer presiding remotely. This second phase is expected to commence no later than March 2023. In the third and final phase, a judicial officer will be on site in Needles to hear matters.

"I am pleased that with continued partnership, and new funding, we are able to restore court services for the residents of Needles and the surrounding areas," said Presiding Judge Yabuno. "Remote areas, such as Needles, present unique challenges, and we are delighted to fulfill this long-term goal of the court."

A ribbon-cutting ceremony will commemorate the expansion of the Needles Courthouse, and further details will be forthcoming.
